Notes for EDITH H WILBURN: Listed in Tipton County, IN marriages Book 2. Shown as married to Isaac Farlam - should be Isaac Farlow. Was some question as to whether Edith's last name was Asburn (as shown in some records) or Wilburn. Fairly certain maiden name was Wilburn based on these marriage records. Edith apparently had three more children by Albin Shaw - but none appear to have survive to adulthood. Burial: McRill Cementery Kinder, Louisiana

11. RUTH ANN⁶ FARLOW (*ISAAC J.⁵, REUBEN⁴, GEORGE³, MICHAEL², JOHN¹*) was born May 17, 1851 in Madison County, Indiana, and died Aft. 1950 in Kinder, Louisiana. She married ISAAC FRANKLIN DENNEY July 26, 1874 in Tipton County, Ind by James Harbit JP, son of HENRY/HARVEY DENNEY and SOPHIA SHAW. He was born February 24, 1846 in Tipton County, Indiana, and died December 06, 1919 in Kinder, Louisiana. Notes for RUTH ANN FARLOW: [Anderson.ftw] I recall Great Grandmother Ruth Ann (Farlow) Denney in my young teen years. My mother (her Granddaughter) had gone to assist in aiding my two Great Aunts, Ruth Ann's daughters, Mannon and Mary in caring for her. At that time, I remember her lying in bed and asked how old she was and recall being told she was 102 years old. Aunt Mannon looked very much like her in her older years.

Search for Ruth Ann Farlow: 1860 Tipton Co. IN census shows only one Farlow. A Sarah A Farlow (age 8) is residing with Ablin (31) and Edith Shaw (32). Ruth Ann's mother moved with the Denneys to Louisiana and is buried with the Denney's. Sarah R (age 18) is found residing with Ablin and Edith Shaw in 1870 but has dropped the Farlow last name. This appears to be the same person as the age is correct and the only Sarah shown in the housefold. It appears that Edith was the mother of Ruth Ann Farlow. No indication of anyother Farlows in the County in 1860. Interestingly enough, there is a Franklin Denney (age 13) shown residing with Isaac and Meranda Shaw in Tipton Co. in 1860. See note on Issac Franklin Denney. Note: Later research shows Edith still with Albin Shaw in 1900 Tipton Co Census, so she apparently did not join her daughter in Louisiana until after 1900.

Our Great Grandmother, Ruth Ann Farlow married Isaac Franklin Denney in Tipton County Indiana in July 26, 1874. Connecting Ruth Ann to the correct Farlow line has not been straightforward.

Her mother was married to an Isaac J. Farlow and Ruth Ann was the only child of that union. However, a family photo signed W R Farlow and penciled in "Uncle Riley" implies that perhaps she had a brother. Note: This turns out to be a half brother by her father's second marriage.

The 1850 Census Record for Madison Co, Indiana (next door to Tipton County) shows an Isaac J. Farlow and Edith. Edith being from North Carolina. A marriage record indicates they were married 15 August 1850 in Tipton County, IN. Her age is given as 23, which would have her birth date around 1827. Family knowledge indicates that she and Isaac Farlow had only one child, that child being Ruth Ann Farlow. This knowledge also indicates that Edith and Isaac divorced and that Edith later married widower Albin Shaw, but probably did not have any children of that marriage.

In the 1860 Madison County Census records, a Edith, age 33 born in North Carolina, is shown married to Albin Shaw. We have a family document in which shows that Edith later wavers all rights to the estate of Ablin Shaw. In 1910 while living in Kinder, La, a family document shows that Edith Shaw sold her rights to Ablin Shaws estate in Tipton Co, IN for \$500 to one Stephen A Whetstone. This Edith is also the correct age range for the Isaac and Edith in the 1850 census and she is also show as being from North Carolina. There are several Shaw children and one female child age 8 named Sarah A Farlow. This Sarah A Farlow would

have been born about 1851-2. This is the right age for Ruth A Farlow. Given that the ages are correct for Edith and Ruth and this Edith is shown from North Carolina and this Edith is married to a Shaw, it is fairly clear that this is our Ruth A Farlow and her mother Edith Wilburn.

There may be some question as to Edith's maiden name. There is record of an Isaac J. Farlow and Edith Wilburn marrying 15 Aug 1850 and a Isaac Farlow and Edith are found in the 1850 Tipton County, IN census. However, other researchers show Isaac J. Farlow's first marriage to a Edith Ashburn. So Wilburn or Ashburn is the question. They are probably the same people and we are confident that Wilburn is the correct maiden name for Edith.

Also in the 1860 Census records, a Franklin Denney is shown living with an Isaac Shaw family in Tipton County. This raises the interesting question - is this our Isaac Franklin Denney? The boy is the correct age. But, if so, what is he doing in Indiana without his family. Well, it turns out that his mother Sophia (Shaw) Denney and father separated during this time frame and his father Harvey (and apparently the older son, Jasper) moved back to Jay Co Indiana around Fort Recovery, Ohio where Harvey was later buried. Isaac Franklin would have been the second child and may have been temporarily left with his Mothers' Shaw kinfolk. We know that by 1862, Isaac Denney had also returned to the Fort Recovery area to join the 40th Ohio Infantry Regiment with which he found in the Civil War. The interesting possibility is that Albin Shaw and Isaac Shaw may have been related and perhaps during visits a young Isaac Franklin Denney met a young Ruth (Sarah?) A Farlow which he return to after the civil war and married. Note: Later Research shows that Albin Shaw was the son of Isaac Shaw or Isaac Franklin's Uncle and brother to Sophia (Shaw) Denney.

After Isaac J Farlow and Edith Wilbrun separated, Isaac moved to Dallas County, Iowa. There he changed the order of his given names, from Isaac J. to Jarome I Farlow. He married Martha Ellen Bringham (some records shows here first name as "Mary"). This family is found in the 1870 Dallas County Iowa census. Here we also find a son Walter R Farlow. This is undoubtedly the same W R Farlow in a 1911 photo with his family. Which is signed "To Mrs. I (Isaac) F (Franklin) Denney from W R Farlow" and penciled on the back of the photo is the annotation "Uncle Riley". This is Ruth Ann Farlows half brother. Later discussion with family members indicates that Ruth Ann Farlows full name may have been Sarah Ruth Ann Farlow. This connection to Isaac Farlow then takes the Farlow lineage back to Michael Farlow of Chester, PA who moved to North Carolina. Burial: McRill Cemetery Kinder, Louisiana

Notes for ISAAC FRANKLIN DENNEY: While Isaac Denney is shown with his parents Harvey and Sophia Denney in Tipton Co., IN in 1850 census, the only Denney shown in 1860 is a Franklin Denney (age 13) residing with Isaac and Meranda Shaw. The only Farlow (Ruth A Farlow - future wife of Isaac Denney) shown on the 1860 census is a Sarah R Farlow (age 8) living with Ablin and Edith Shaw. Since Issac Denney's mother was Sophia Shaw prior to marrying Harvey Denney, it is very likely that both Shaws families are relatives of the Isaac Denney. It is possible that Isaac and Ruth knew each other as children staying with Shaw relatives.

The records show that Sophia left the family in 1860 and that Harvey reportedly returned to Ft Recovery, Ohio area and is buried there. It is possible that Harvey and his older sons moved with him back to Ohio after their mother died in 1860 and that Isaac being the youngest child was left with a family that had a mother. It appears that Isaac Denney rejoined his family in Ohio in a few years as he enlisted in the Ohio 40th Infantry Regiment at Ft. Recovery Ohio with two of his brothers in August 1862 at the age of 16.

Note: The placing of Henry Denney's children with others is further born out with the following notation.:

Harvey Denney was shown living with his father Harrel with a Post Office of Fort Recovery, Ohio in the 1860 Jay County, IN census. No wife or children shown with him. His wife may have died and he returned to live with the parents and may have adopted out the children. This idea may further be backed up with the fact that there was a Jasper Denney age 14 (correct age for his son) shown living with William Ault next door to Harrel and Henry during the 1860 census. Source Title: S2 William Denney, Vancouver, WA Media: Book. Richard F. Denney's WEB site

Note: Later research shows that Issac and Albin Shaw were related. There was an Isaac and Albin Shaw sons of Knowles Shaw born in Ohio around 1810. The Isaac Shaw shown in 1860 census with Franklin Denney is his Uncle and the same Albin Shaw shown in the 1850 census with Edith [Farlow-Wilson]. This Albin is likely the son of Isaac Shaw.

Note: Even later research shows that Isaac Denney's mother, Sophia, had left the family and married John Darrow Tipton Co IN 1860 Census. She had with her the two younger Denney brothers Albin/Albert and Thomas Denney. Also she lived only 10 house holds from Albin Shaw with whom Ruth Ann Farlow is living with in 1860. So Isaac Franklin Denney undoubtedly must have visited his mother and two brothers after the family broke up and before he join to fight in the civil war. This adds even more credibility to the theory that he must have visited and met the lovely Ruth Ann Farlow only living 10 houses away with another Shaw Family and later returned from the Civil war and married her in 1874

Isaac with Ruth, Maude? and Edith M shown living with Christian Long and wife Suanna in 1880 Dallas County, IA census in Cofax Township, Page 11, Image 10. So apparently did not own his home at time. This record shows that Maude was born 1876 and Edith M born 1878. Isaac Denney Purchased 80 acres of land in Kinder, Louisiana in 1893. Military Record: Isaac joined the 40th on 14 August 1862 in Ft. Recovery, Ohio

In Isaac Denney's declaration for Pension (Civil War) in 24 Feb 1913 (on his 70th birthday), the application form contains the following information: Height 5' 5"; Complexion:Light; Eyes:blue; Hair:dark. Enlisted at Fort Recovery, Ohio 14 Aug 1862 (he would have been 19 According to his birth date). Lived in Tipton, IN until 1876, from then to 1890 in Dallas County, Iowa and since 1890 in Calcasieu Parish Louisiana (his residence, Kinder is now is Allen Parish)

Note: Isaac Denney apparently was not truthful about his age when he enlisted in 1862. He stated on the enlistment form he was 19 years of age which would have meant he was born in 1843. However, every census record including the 1900 one where the month and year of birth are stated rather than just the age, he gives his date of birth as 1846 not 1843 - at first I thought the 1843 on the enlistment form might have been an "honest" mistake. That is until I saw the date Isaac used on his pension application in 1913 which was again 1843. So he was smart enough to know that the information on his pension application needed to be consistent with that in his military records - otherwise he stood the risk of rejection. Burial: McRill Cemetery Kinder, Louisiana

Denney mailed from Corpus Christi to President Roosevelt asking that the civil war pension being collected by RuthAnn Denney be transferred to her daughters, Mary and Manon. The request was denied due to no provisions in the law for children over 16 of a veteran receiving the benefits. The question has been who was A. Denney that wrote this letter? Sister Billy Cronan provided this possibility: "I do believe that both Great Uncle Walter worked with Great Uncle Lafon in Corpus Christi, Texas. (They also worked together in Galveston, Texas) Anyway, Great Uncle Walter's second wife was named Anne. I would bet that the letter from Corpus Christi regarding Granny's pension being transferred to her daughters was written by her."

Notes for BENJAMIN BERNARD BERTRAND: Benjamin Bertrand reportedly was able to receive an education in that the treasure that his Father Soloman Bertrand found in a tree was in part used for his son's education. Benjamin had beautiful hand writing and was in demand to make "Calling cards". Apparently he was held as a man of humor, we would call him the "Life of the Party" told jokes and was generally held in good regard by most. By most, but not all. Unfortunately, Benjamin was not what you would call successful in business ventures and apparently was in debt frequently. He was also a bit of a cocky man which probably did not help.

The story is told that the local town sheriff who in those days rode a horse and had a six shooter strapped to his waist had more than one occasion called on Benjamin about his debts. So there was apparently no love lost between the two men. A family story has it that during one such altercation the sheriff was sitting on his horse when the exchange of words with Benjamin became heated. The sheriff is reported to have said "If I had someone to hold this horse I would get down and give you a beating!" to which Benjamin's response was "Get down, I'll hold the horse with one hand while I whip you with the other!"

KY Oct 6 1895 to Ed and Enda Laura Bell (Neighbors) Anderson Insurance form filled out in 1836 shows his father Ed Anderson as being born in Clinton Co, KY (formed from Cumberland co in 1837). Mentioned living with his Uncle B. G. Neighbors, a Judge, in San Marcus Texas. Basley Graves Neighbors and family are listed in 1900 Hays Co, TX census (B.G as a lawyer). B.G Neighbors died as a Judge in Mar 1932. So William apparently stay with the family as claimed sometime after 1906 and before 1910.

This connection with B.G Neighbors is the convincing evidence of William T. Anderson connection to Enda Laura Bell Neighbors and by record with Ed Anderson. I have discovered no record of his birth anywhere. However, he was listed as "Willie" with father and brothers in 1900 Fannin Co., TX census.

I am named after my Grandfather Ed Anderson - another connection. Any lineage shown after this Ed Anderson is pure speculation on my part. [Note: we now know who Ed T Anderson parents were - thanks to cousin LindaKaye]

William T Anderson claimed that his parents moved to Mexico City, Mexico where he was supposedly born. The parents perished of an epidemic and he was supposedly retrieved and raised by his paternal Grandmother, Mary Anderson. At age 10, they supposedly moved to Denton Texas where after his grandmother died, he was placed in an orphanage which he ran away from at age 13. While there is no evidence to support any of this, their is the puzzling absence of any record of the family(including Williams birth) after the 1900s. Something disaster may have befallen the family leaving him an orphan. It appears that the much of the Neighbors family did move to Texas as I have found a cousin Kelly Nate Neighbors who died in Donley Co, TX.

Since writing the above paragraph, I am happy to say new information has cause a lot of pieces of the puzzle to start to fit together. While conducting a "brute force" type search by looking at every Ed Anderson in the 1900 Fannin Co, Texas Federal Census I found the family consisting at that time of:

James, William and Arvin are all children names associated with Laura and Ed Anderson in sparse records in KY. So what story does this possibly tell.

It appears that based on the birth dates of the children that Ed Anderson and Laura Neighbors married around 1883, had James B. 1884, William B. 1886 and Arvin B. 1889. Laura apparently died shortly after Arvins birth perhaps in 1889 as a complication of childbirth. Ed then apparently farmed out his children to various members of the family or friends. His mother, Mary Anderson, apparently kept my father, William. My father claimed he was raised by his Grandmother until around 10 years old when she passe away. No record have yet been found of whom might have kept James and Arvin during this period. .

It appears that once Ed Anderson remarried he then sent for his family. Based on my father's story about going with his grandmother to Trenton, TX (in Fannin Co, TX), it appears that Ed convinced his mother (apparently a widow by this time) to join him in Trenton, TX. This would have been around 1896-99 time frame. My father claimed he was orphaned at 13, his Grandmothers property was put on a "Sheriffs tax sale" and he was placed in an orphanage. I had always though he was living alone with his grandmother in Trenton as he never once mentioned his father or brothers. I suspect he did not know his brother's well and probably had trouble fitting in with a step mother once his grandmother died. In any case, he claimed he ran away from the orphanage around 13 years of age. I had thought he was referring to his grandmothers passing as what had made him an orphan, but it his father died in 1906 which truly make him an orphan at age 20.

He afterwards visited his mother's brother, his Uncle Basley Graves Neighbors, in San Marcus, TX (See record of Basley Graves Neighbors). He always referred to his Uncle as Judge B.G Graves apparent not knowing the initials stood for Basley Graves.

The stories that my father told about laying rail roads in Oklahoma also fall into place. He was probably familiar and comfortable with the occupation that his father had practiced - Rail Road Section Worker. Also, the period 1899-1916 was a period when 10 different rail companies were laying rail roads in Oklahoma. I believe that he went from the rail roads to the oil field worker occupation during the Oklahoma oil boom in the early 1900s. This remain his occupation for the remainder of his life following the oil well drilling bushiness from one boom area to another leading him finally into Louisiana in the mid 1930s where he eventually met our Mother , Letha Ellen Bertrand going to college in Layfaette, LA. They were married and I became the first born on 19 Jan 1940 named after my Grandfather Ed Anderson.

After a life time of wondering and 22 years after my father has passed away, my sisters, Billy Darlene and Mary Lois have some knowledge of him and our line and therefore some closure. We also are able to pass on to our descendents this knowledge which could have been lost forever.
